TERMS OF REFERENCE

HIGHER EDUCATION COMMITTEE

CONSTITUTION

The Higher Education Committee should consist in senior members of the profession with a track record in responding to higher education policy issues, including at least one person from all of the regions. The committee will consist in the following members:

1. Convener of the Committee
2. Immediate Past Convener of the Committee (if there is one and they are willing)
3. Ordinary member(s)
4. Postgraduate student member
5. New Zealand
6. Singapore

The committee may have further members, as many as deemed necessary for its necessary functioning, although consideration should be given to a maximum size of 7 or 8 members, as more may prove unwieldy. One member of the committee will act as Secretary.

FUNCTION

- To assist the Executive in monitoring the Sector (Government; Public Service Departments; Granting Agencies; etc.)
 - Develop and sustain relationships with relevant HASS bodies (e.g. Academies; Deans' Associations; etc.).
- To determine whether AAP submission is warranted.
- To determine whether solo AAP submission is warranted.
- To draft solo submissions.
- To monitor Media.
- To draft responses as appropriate.

REPORTING

Quarterly reports to the Executive should list what has come up and what was done, even if no further action was taken.
