TERMS OF REFERENCE

POSTGRADUATE STUDENT COMMITTEE

CONSTITUTION

The Postgraduate Student Committee will consist of the following members, including at least one person from all of the regions:

1. Convener of the Committee (Postgraduate Rep/Chair of PGSC)
2. Immediate Past Convener of the Committee
3. Ordinary member(s)
4. Advisor/mentor to the committee (an academic ideally at the University from which the convener comes)
5. New Zealand member
6. Singapore member

The committee may have further members, as many as deemed necessary for its necessary functioning, although consideration should be given to a maximum size of 7 or 8 members, as more may prove unwieldy. One member of the committee will act as Secretary.

FUNCTION

- To represent philosophy postgraduate students in Australasia.
- To advise the Executive on matters of importance to undergraduate philosophy students.
- To facilitate the annual Australasian Postgraduate Philosophy conference, including managing the bidding process and selection of the host of the conference.
- To develop and undertake projects to support philosophy postgraduates in Australasia.
- To liaise on a needs be basis with the convener of the Undergraduate Student Committee on matters of mutual relevance.

SCHEDULE A

To facilitate and coordinate the bidding for postgraduate conferences in philosophy and to make recommendations to the Executive about the allocation of postgraduate conference funds in any given year.
