TERMS OF REFERENCE

PRESIDENTIAL COMMITTEE

CONSTITUTION

The Presidential Committee will consist of members seconded by the President at the beginning of the Presidential term. The committee will consist in the following members:

1. Convener of the Committee (President)
2. Immediate Past President
3. Other member(s)

The committee may have further members, as many as deemed necessary for its necessary functioning, although consideration should be given to a maximum size of 7 or 8 members, as more may prove unwieldy. One member of the committee will act as Secretary/Project Manager.

FUNCTION

- The Presidential Committee addresses issues of concern to the profession that would not otherwise be addressed by the Association.
- Typically, the Presidential Committee will take on a defined project that runs for two years.

OUTCOMES

Typically the Presidential Committee will deliver a project(s) and produce a report for the AGM In July of the following year.
