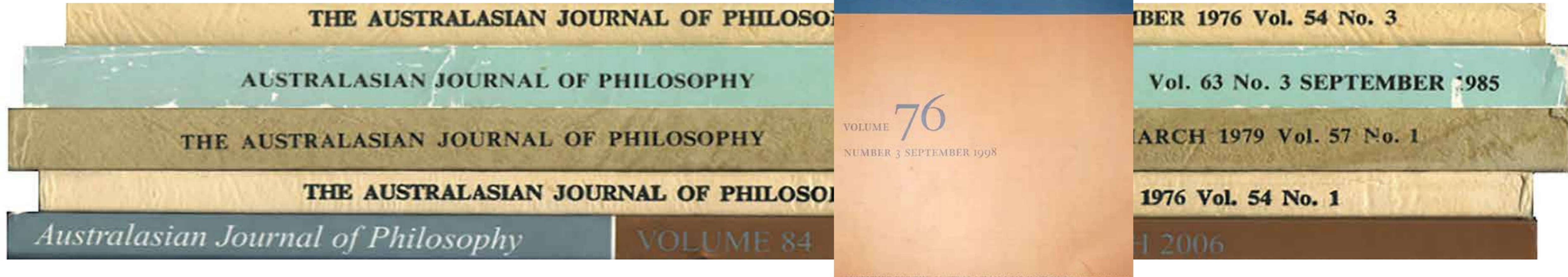


Australasian Journal of Philosophy

In 2007 it was rated 'A' (the highest category) in the European Reference Index in the Humanities (ERIH) and in 2010 'A*' (the highest category) in the Australian Research Council's 'Excellence in Research for Australia' (ERA) journal ranking list. 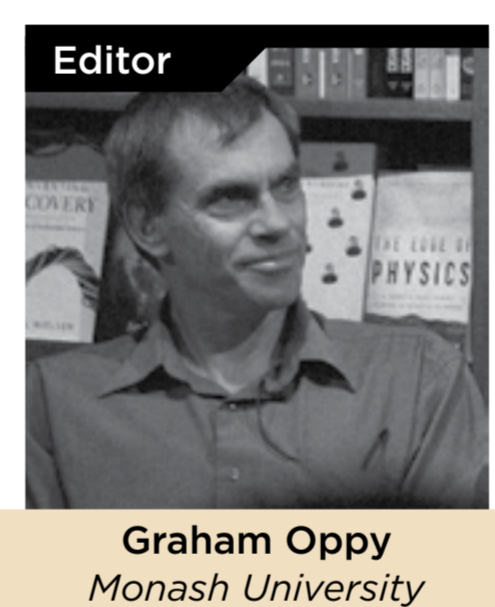
