TERMS OF REFERENCE

AUSTRALASIAN JOURNAL OF PHILOSOPHY COMMITTEE

CONSTITUTION

The *Australasian Journal of Philosophy* (AJP) Committee will consist of three or four members.

Membership of the Committee will typically be for a three-year term.

Members of the Committee will typically be appointed together, and will work out among themselves who shall act as Convener in any given year.

Members of the Committee will be appointed by the Executive. Consideration of diversity should be taken into account when a Committee is established.

FUNCTION

The AJP Committee will judge the AAP Best Paper Prize.

Members of the Committee are required to read all of the articles published in the AJP for the year for which the Prize is being judged, and to arrive at a decision about the awarding of the Prize.
